WE ACT TCTAC Overview

WE ACT for Environmental Justice has launched the EPA Region 2 Thriving Communities Technical Assistance Center (TCTAC), serving New York and New Jersey. The WE ACT TCTAC can help underserved communities access grant and funding opportunities to advance and address environmental, climate, and energy justice issues. We offer training and technical assistance (TA) to build capacity for navigating grant application systems, writing strong grant proposals, effectively managing grants, and engaging in environmental and energy justice decision-making.

WE ACT TCTAC Community Voices Context

The WE ACT TCTAC will build a rotating network of community outreach voices to support its in-person outreach throughout New York and New Jersey, ensuring the amplification of communities across our region.

The WE ACT TCTAC Community Voice cohort aims to provide the following:

1. Provide local support curated to meet the needs of regions throughout New York and New Jersey.
2. Conduct outreach to regional Environmental Justice communities, ensuring they can utilize TCTAC services.
3. Support design and facilitation of in-person training in their region.
4. Provide feedback on the design, implementation, and impact of the TCTAC program.

The TCTAC Community Voices will provide essential insight into the needs of their region and help facilitate in-person training while also playing a role in connecting the community to the full array of resources and technical support provided by the WE ACT TCTAC. The TCTAC Community Voices will also be crucial in achieving our movement-building goals. TCTAC Community Voices participants will meet throughout the two-year partnership to determine regional priorities regarding environmental justice, climate justice, and energy justice, which will inform a Regional Environmental Justice Network in subsequent years of the project. TCTAC Community Voices receive \$15,000 in year one and \$10,000 in year two, with a total budget of \$25,000.00. We aim to ensure equitable compensation for facilitating regional in-person training, integrating WE ACT TCTAC outreach collateral into existing organization programming, and time and effort. The WE ACT TCTAC will cover all event costs, including nonlabor services.

Terms and Budget

The agreement with the selected TCTAC Community Voices participants will last two years, from July 1, 2024, through June 30, 2026. The not-to-exceed budget will be \$15,000.00 in year one and \$10,000.00 in year two, invoiced quarterly. The budget includes all staff time and approved non-labor expenses, except for WE ACT TCTAC in-person sponsored training.

Selection Criteria

- Organizations serving environmental justice communities based on the EPA [CEJST](#) and [EJScreen](#)
- Capacity to attend virtual and in-person events.
- Experience designing and delivering services to diverse communities with various needs, including language barriers, historically underserved communities, and communities impacted by environmental injustices.
- Serving communities with varying.
